Two-Man Better Ball

Boundary Oak Golf Course

All participants must pay \$5.00 to the treasurer to enter this event.

Format: A competition in which two golfers play as a team, but each playing his own ball at stroke play throughout. Players must calculate the number of strokes allowed on each hole based upon their handicap for the course. On each hole, the two golfers on a team compare their net scores. The lower of the two net scores - *the better ball* - counts as the team's score.

For example, Player A and Player B make up a team:

On the first hole, A scores net 6 and B scores net 5. B's 5 is the team score on Hole 1. On the second hole, A scores net 4 and B scores net 6. A's 4 is team score on Hole 2. On the third hole, A & B each scores net 3. 3 is the team score on Hole 3. So the team's aggregate score after three holes is 12.

Continue this process for 18 holes and total the team's net score after 9 and 18 holes, then sign the cards. After the cards are turned in, tabulation of each team's score will be verified for accuracy.
